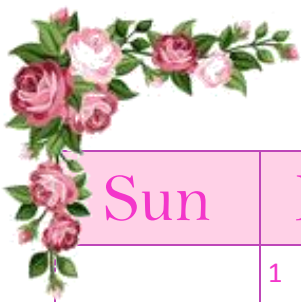

The property owner has an active building permit that will expire on January 12, 2018. Some work has been done to the property.

10. The Chamber, City of Taft, vendors, volunteers, and businesses is released from liability that can occur from participation.
