

Westside Health Care District Receives \$4 Million Dollar Anonymous Gift for New Health Care Facility— From: Taft Independent

The Westside Health Care District has received a generous \$4 million anonymous donation for the construction of the districts new heath care facility.

The news means that the district will not have to get a \$4 million loan from the Department of Housing and Urban Developing, saving the district tens of thousands of dollars in interest payments on the loan, according to District General Manager Jerry Starr.

The district will take \$5.3 million dollars that it had saved from reserves and pay cash for the new facility along with the \$4 million gift, to pay the entire cost of the \$9 million facility that will be built on the site of the old Taft Hospital.

"The District is very fortunate," said Starr. The donation will go towards serving the district and serving the people of the Westside."

The funds will be given to the district's non-profit foundation in 4 payments over the next 12 months. While not a hospital, the new facility will offer primary care services. Construction should begin by mid-August, according to Starr.

The existing Westside Family Urgent Care will remain open during construction.
