



Executive Directions

Your Taft Chamber spent the last three days of the month of August in San Diego at the International Conference of Shopping Centers (ICSC). Maddison and I traveled to the San Diego Convention Center with Taft City Manager Craig Jones and his Assistant Belinda Cole and City Planner Mark Staples and his Assistant Brenda Johns while Shannon held down the fort at the Chamber office. We missed her at the conference, but the Gala is coming, and there are many details that need her attention.

The ICSC Conference is a meet-and-greet, deal-making experience that takes place in a room the size of four football fields. Taft's booth, though not the largest (by a long-shot), is one of the most attractive. The City and the Chamber collaborated to showcase our City and its opportunities in an attractive display.

The largest (longest) day was Wednesday. Maddison and I rotated "booth time" with the folks from the City, alternating sharing information and answering questions with walking around inviting people to visit our booth and discussing the possibilities of bringing their businesses to Taft. The booth was effective in enticing people to stop and chat (people love our flashing American flag pins and chances to win a basket of Taft goodies); our crew was successful in listening to needs and suggesting properties.

This is the fourth year the Chamber has been invited to join the City in this trek to San Diego. It is a great opportunity to learn for what properties folks are looking, the trends in retail that are emerging, and the challenges to growth that currently are trending. As we speak to people from other regions, we learn what the next new economic ideas for growth are getting traction. We also learn, just through conversation, what issues cities our size are facing—whether in regulation, law enforcement, budgeting, and economics. This conference is helpful on many levels.

As you are aware, the Chamber is very proud to represent our business community wherever we go. It is an added bonus to be able to share Taft with folks on a grander stage, away from Kern County, at an international conference. We are grateful for the chance to work alongside our City officials to add a practical (and sometimes historical) assessment of the opportunities available in Taft.


